Paducah Cooperative Ministry has asked us to collect breakfast cereal during March. Because this item costs a bit more, our goal is 250 units. Thanks for your help.

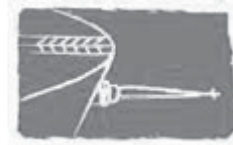
