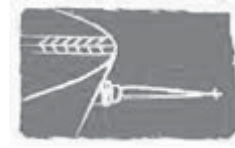

Needed: food for Spring Break

School breaks provide a difficult challenge for low-income children. Many children in our community have meals only when they are at school, and weekends and breaks greatly reduce the amount of nutritious, filling food they have to eat. For Fall and Christmas Break our congregation rose in a magnificent way and supplied enough food for over 80 McNabb elementary students to take home to provide extra nutrition while school was out. Because the need still exists we're going to repeat the program for Spring break. The Outreach committee is asking FCC members to bring in food for children to take home for the break. Donated food is needed before **Wednesday, March 31**. We will bag the food for distribution that night after the church dinner. The snacks gathered need to be non-perishable's—nutritious but delicious, no cooking (except for microwave), including drinks such as boxed juice, capri sun, etc.). McNabb Elementary has over 400 students with 90 percent receiving free school lunch. Remember, there is no free lunch on Spring break!

Needed: 5000 filled plastic Easter eggs

The Outreach and Christian Education committees have moved the date for the Easter Egg Hunt up one week to March 27.
